ENG 2DI: Build a Sonnet Assignment.

Your task...is to build your own sonnet.

A Shakespearean sonnet is built using the following materials:

- 1. A sonnet is fourteen (14) lines long.
- 2. It has a defined rhythm or meter called iambic pentameter (five hard syllables and five soft syllables which alternate in each line!)
- 3. It has a defined rhyme scheme: Ababa cdcd efef gg.
- 4. The last two lines are called a couplet- this means these two lines rhyme and solves the problem or issue raided in the previous twelve lines.

So how will you go about this?

- Stage #1. Come up with a list of possible topics
- Stage #2. List a number of things you could write about this topic.
- Stage #3. Start to fill out the lines.
- Stage #4. Develop the rhyme scheme
- Stage #5. Make a couplet.
- Stage #6. Creatively display your Sonnet!
