## **ETS 4UI Course Outline**

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Attendance: Attendance is vital to your success in this course. Late Policy: All assignments will be collected at the beginning of class. If a student hands an assignment in after this it will receive a 10% deduction. Students will only be penalized a maximum of 20% for late assignments. However, if the teacher hands back the assignments before a student turns in an assignment, the student will receive a mark of zero. For some assignments, students may still be required to turn in assignments, especially for the ISU, in order to continue with the remainder of the project. Failure to do this could jeopardize the student's mark regarding the entire assignment. Please refer to the Independent Study Contact for further clarification.

If an assignment is due on a Friday, and a student fails to hand it in, then the teacher will deduct 10%. If the student cannot hand the assignment in before the following Monday, there will be another deduction of 10%.
